RESOLUTION 2016-38**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE WITH A1A BUTCH BLAST, INC. FOR A COATINGS UPGRADE FOR THE SERVICE AREA 5 WWTP CHLORINE CONTACT TANKS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$38,750.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon (the “City”) Purchased the Service Area 5 (Little Venice) wastewater treatment facility, and

WHEREAS, the City continues to upgrade the facility in order to comply with all FDEP permit requirements, and

WHEREAS, City staff solicited quotes from five contractors, with A1A Butch Blast, Inc. having the lowest bid; and

WHEREAS, the City staff wishes to expend budgeted funds for sandblasting and upgrading the coatings on the chlorine contact tanks in an amount not to exceed \$38,750.00 with A1A Butch Blast, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Council waives the purchasing policy requiring formal sealed bids.

Section 3. The proposal from Butch Blast attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney is hereby approved. The City Manager is authorized to execute the acceptance of the proposal and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


