RESOLUTION 2016-70**

**A RESOLUTION OF CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, ADOPTING
THE TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017; AND
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, *Florida Statutes* the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") has established a proposed millage rate; and

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2016, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to consider its tentative budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 ("FY 2016-2017"), and adopt a tentative millage rate in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes*; and

WHEREAS, the City has set forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the tentative operating budget for FY 2016-2017 in the amount of \$62,577,353.00.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The FY 2016-2017 tentative budget is hereby adopted.

Section 3 This resolution will take effect immediately upon its adoption.


