RESOLUTION 2016-84**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE AND LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF MARATHON OF MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2016, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to adopt a tentative millage rate, and to adopt a tentative operating budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 (the "FY 2016-2017"), in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes* and

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2016, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its tentative millage rate, to adopt a final millage rate and to adopt a final operating budget for FY 2016-2017, in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(d), *Florida Statutes*.

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2016, the City Council re-held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its millage rate, to adopt a final millage rate and to adopt a final operating budget for FY 2016-2017, in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(d), *Florida Statutes*.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The FY 2016-2017 final operating millage rate for the City is 2.500 mills, which is more than the rolled-back rate of 2.1590 mills by 15.79%.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
