A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A "PIGGY BACK PURCHASE" PURSUANT TO THE CITY'S PROCUREMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES OF A NEW ENGINE UNDER THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S CONTRACT BID #16-VEF12.0 FROM PIERCE MANUFACTURING, INC. IN A PRE-PAID AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$554,293.70; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROPRIATE AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2014-15, the City adopted purchasing policies and procedures (the "Purchasing Policies and Procedures") after determining that it was fiscally prudent and in the City's best interest to adopt policies and procedures for City employees and officials regarding the acquisition and purchase of contractual services, equipment, goods, and other similar types of services; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-184(3) of the City's Purchasing Policies and Procedures allow the City Council to enter into contracts for materials, supplies, equipment, public improvements or services without competitive bidding by utilizing existing contract terms and prices entered into by other local, state or federal governmental authorities that followed a competitive bidding procedure leading to the award of the contract in question; and

WHEREAS, the automotive fire apparatus ("Engine") will replace the current Engine 14, which will be used as a back-up vehicle when one of the units are out of service and will be equipped with industry leading firefighting capabilities including a compressed air foam system; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of the new engine will limit out of service times and afford an additional engine should one be required in an emergency, and for disaster readiness. Since it is the same manufacturer as the current Engine 14, additional preventative maintenance material and knowledge will not be required; and

WHEREAS, the \$554,293.70 cost includes a pre-pay discount of \$26,000 of the Engine which is based on the competitively bid Florida Sheriff's Association Bid #16-VEF12.0, as required by the Purchasing Policies and Procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to expend budgeted funds with Pierce Manufacturing for the purchase of an Automotive Fire Apparatus in an amount not to exceed \$554,293.70 based on the competitively bid Florida Sheriff's Association Bid #16-VEF12.0.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Chief. In this budget we have allocated funds for the purchase of a new engine to replace the current Engine 14.

Using the FSA contract it was determined that Pierce manufacturing would be the best choice for our operations.

- The engine will be manufactured in Bradenton Florida
- Offers the closest service center (Pompano Beach)
- Equipped with CAFS (compressed air foam system)
- Has the additional fire equipment required
- Meets Current NFPA standard
- Includes Motorola 800 MHZ radio
- Same manufacture as our current Engine 14. Will have same normal wear items as current engine. No learning curve in preventative truck body maintenance
- Same engine and transmission as current Engine 14. This offers a benefit since there will not be need to stock additional preventive maintenance items




