**WHEREAS**, the City wishes except this change order, which will enable the City to include improved EQ Tank and filter coatings, sound wall modifications and air conditioning unit access and relocation of the exisiitng reuse line and odor control slab.

**Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 2.** The contract attached hereto as Exhibit "A", together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney is hereby approved. The City Manager is authorized to execute the contract and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
