RESOLUTION 2017-54**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2016-113, AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN MONROE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF MARATHON TRANSFERRING AFFORDABLE HOUSING RESIDENTIAL ALLOCATIONS FOR A PROJECT KNOWN AS KEYS AFFORDABLE DEVELOPMENT III, LLC.; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon (the “City”) wishes to rescind Resolution 2016-113, an Interlocal Agreement with Monroe County (the “County”) for the purpose of Transferring affordable housing unit allocations ; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to adopt a new Resolution for the same purpose, but with revised conditions; and

WHEREAS, rescission of the Interlocal Agreement with the County, as adopted through Resolution 206-113, is in the best interest of Monroe County and the City of Marathon for the purposes of providing opportunities for affordable housing,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The Interlocal Agreement (ILA), as approved pursuant to Resolution 2016-113, is hereby rescinded.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
