RESOLUTION 2013-32

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, RANKING THE SUBMITTED PROPOSALS FOR DESIGN AND MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CITY HALL BUILDING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE A CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY WITH THE TOP RANKED SUBMITTER; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon (the “City”) issued a Request for Proposals on February 9, 2013 for the selection of an architect to design and serve as the project manager for the construction of a City Hall building (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, eight proposals were received and evaluated by the City’s evaluation committee, shortlisted and ranked the firms at a publicly noticed evaluation committee meeting held on March 26, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the City evaluation committee recommends to the City Council that it accept the rankings of the submitted proposals and authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate a design and management contract for the Project with the top ranked named firm or, if negotiations fail with the highest ranked firm, then with the next higher ranked firm, for subsequent submittal to the City Council for review and approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council hereby ranks the top three (3) firms who responded to the subject Request for Proposals as follows:

- (1). William P. Horn, Architect, P.A.
- (2). Solaria Design and Consulting Co.
- (3). Currie Sowards Aguila Architects.

Section 3. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to negotiate a contract with the top ranked submitter for subsequent submittal to the City Council for review and approval. If negotiations are not successful with the top ranked firm, the City Manager and City Attorney shall proceed with negotiations with the next ranked firm or firms in the order of ranking.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


