**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH SD DATA CENTER FOR CYBER SECURITY SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$14,291.40 PER YEAR FOR A THREE YEAR PERIOD; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT AND APPROPRIATE AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, due to recent increased ransomware and cyber-attacks on Local, State and Federal governments, the City is in need a powerful cyber-security defense platform; and

**WHEREAS**; SD Data Center (the “Contractor”) will provide quarterly and annual reporting, monthly alerting, cyber security training and protection; and

**WHEREAS**, the City finds that entering into a contract with the Contractor is in the best interest of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

**Section 2.** The Contract between the City and the Contractor for cyber security in an amount not to exceed \$14291.40, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit “A,” together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney, is hereby approved. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Contract and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

In response to the City's cybersecurity needs ENS and SD Data Center are proposing a layered approach to network and data protection that starts with the employee and carries through to third party monitoring and response.

- **Cybersecurity Awareness Training Services** – A learning management system that delivers specialized cybersecurity training will help train and educate train the city's employees and contractors on best practices that ultimately strengthen the organization as a whole. This service will include phishing attempts that will heighten awareness and further identify employees who require additional training.
- **Darkweb Monitoring Services** – By monitoring the darkweb for potential data breaches we can proactively react to issues where employee credentials have been compromised and made available to individuals or organizations that might seek to do harm through the use of the compromised data.
- **DNS Protection Services** – With the addition of protected domain name services we can prevent users from inadvertently going to websites that are known to be infected or malicious.
- **Security Operations Center Services** – By implementing 24x7 specialized security monitoring services on all devices at the network edge and all mission critical servers and workstations we can react to unwanted network activity quickly with dedicated security specialists who are trained in cybersecurity processes and remediation of issues.
- **Policy Assessment and Review Services** – Using a NIST assessment tool, we will work with the city's leadership team to identify policies and procedures that are missing or fall short of best practice recommendations.
- **Quarterly Pentesting and Security Assessment Services** – Through the use of assessment tools and services, we will perform quarterly network penetration testing and security assessment review that will identify any new risks and provide evidence that the city has taken appropriate actions to strengthen their security posture and protect the interests of its constituents.
