**A RESOLUTION OF CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, ADOPTING
THE TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021; AND
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, *Florida Statutes* the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") has established a proposed millage rate; and

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2020, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to consider its tentative budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 ("FY 2020-2021"), and adopt a tentative millage rate in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes*; and

WHEREAS, the City has set forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the tentative operating budget for FY 2020-2021 in the amount of \$97,368,116

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.
- Section 2.** The FY 2020-2021 tentative budget is hereby adopted.
- Section 3.** This resolution will take effect immediately upon its adoption.
