#### CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA RESOLUTION 2022-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, APPROVING REPLACEMENT PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AT ROTARY PARK; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH PLAY BY DESIGN VIA SOURCEWELL AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$501,705.60; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, SourceWell is a public agency that offers competitively solicited purchasing contracts for products and equipment to member agencies, so those members do not have to duplicate the solicitation process; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Marathon (the "City") qualifies to take advantage of the cooperative purchasing contract 010521-BUR (SourceWell) with Play By Design; and

WHEREAS, the City recommends that the Council authorizes the purchase of playground equipment in the amount of \$501,705.60

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

- **Section 1**. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- **Section 2**. The City Council authorizes the purchase of playground equipment in the amount of \$501,705.60, a copy of the proposal which is attached as Exhibit "A," together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney, is hereby approved. The City Manager is authorized to expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.
  - **Section 3**. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

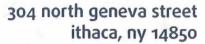
