

**CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION 2024-69**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, RESTRICTING PARKING ON CERTAIN RIGHTS-OF-WAY ON SOMBRERO BEACH ROAD PURSUANT TO CITY CODE SECTION 32-31(A); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Sombrero Beach Road Right-Of-Way near the Sombrero Beach Park frequently exhibits congested overflow parking during active days at the beach; and

WHEREAS, there has been documented use of both private and commercial vehicles parking in this right of way in the past; and

WHEREAS, the overflow parking thus exhibited disrupts the efficient functions the residences as they enter or leave their driveways or otherwise carry out the normal day-to-day operations of residential living or that of Vacation Rental operations; and

WHEREAS, restricting parking on the streets of the surrounding residential neighborhood is deemed to be in the best interest of the public; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 32-31(a) of the City Code, the City Council may by resolution restrict or prohibit parking, standing or stopping of vehicles along roads in the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. No person may park a vehicle or equipment within the right-of-way of the Sombrero Beach Park residence to Spoonbill Drive along both sides of the Right-Of-Way of Sombrero Beach Road. The City Council may relax entirely this restriction by their specific direction provided at a Council meeting for requested events and holidays. The 4th of July holiday shall be a specific exception for enforcement of this no parking zone. The penalties and procedures for violations shall be as set forth in Section 32-31(e) of the City Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption of Ordinance 2024-2024-09.
