RESOLUTION 2024-76**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, EXTENDING THE APPROVAL OF THE ALLOCATIONS OF THE EARLY EVACUATION BUILDING PERMIT ALLOCATION SYSTEM (EE-BPAS) UNDER RESOLUTION 2021-77, PROVIDING 6 MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION FOR THE PERMITS TO BE ISSUED; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon City Council (the “City”) approved the award of Early Evacuation Units through Resolution 2021-77;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to see more affordable housing constructed in the City of Marathon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council hereby grants an additional six months for the applicants to obtain permits.

Section 3. The City Council may grant additional extension through resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
