WHEREAS, the City of Marathon ("City") desires to purchase an ambulance to be utilized by the City in order to facilitate the City's efforts to provide emergency medical services commencing April 1, 2002.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Recitals</u>. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Marathon ("City") hereby approves the purchase of said ambulance (a copy of specifications and information attached as Exhibit "A"). The City Manager and the City Attorney are authorized to finalize the terms and conditions of any documentation necessary to facilitate said purchase, if necessary, and the Mayor is authorized to execute any documentation necessary for said purchase on behalf of the City.
